Driving Policy- No driving will be permitted on camp without a valid, color-coded pass. Passes will be distributed as needed only to drivers with a valid license and insurance card. If you do not receive a pass, please park your vehicle in the parking lot for the duration of the event. Youth younger than 18 cannot drive once on camp. Youth aged 18-21 cannot drive passengers under 21; adults over 21 may drive with passengers. Passengers and drivers must wear seatbelts.

Camping Policy- Please remember to camp in your assigned campsite. A committee with prior approval from the lodge adviser may camp away from the chapter due to committee obligations.

Check-In/ Check-Out Policy- If any youth under 18 leaves camp before Sunday morning, they must check out at the Ames Lodge and check back upon return. The BSA two-deep leadership policy must be followed. Youth 18-21 may leave camp alone with lodge adviser approval.
