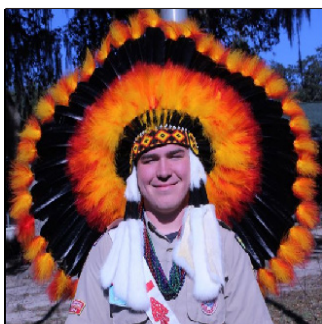

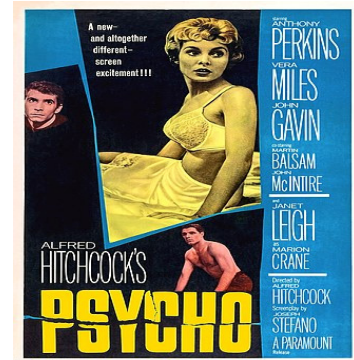

## Seminole

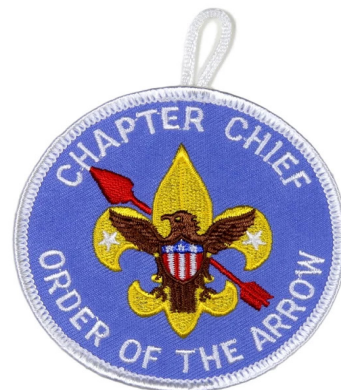
Hello Echockotee Lodge,
