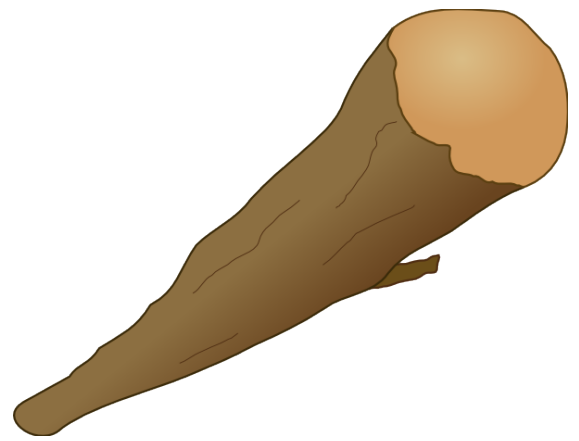
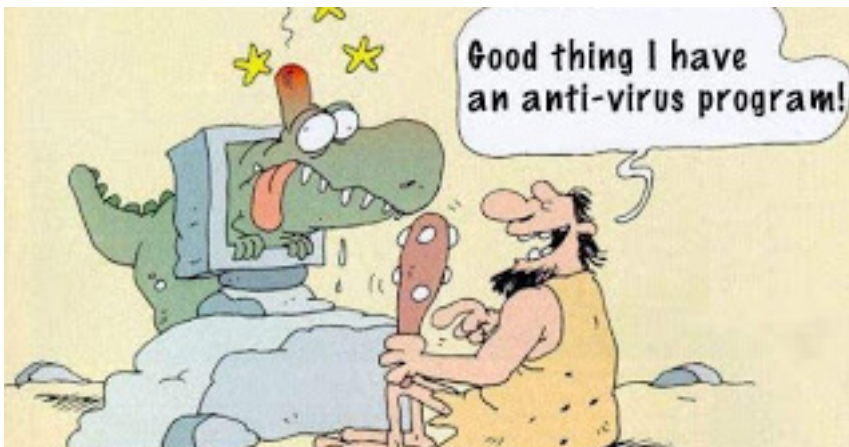

- With time, bronze replaced stone as the primary material for tools and weapons

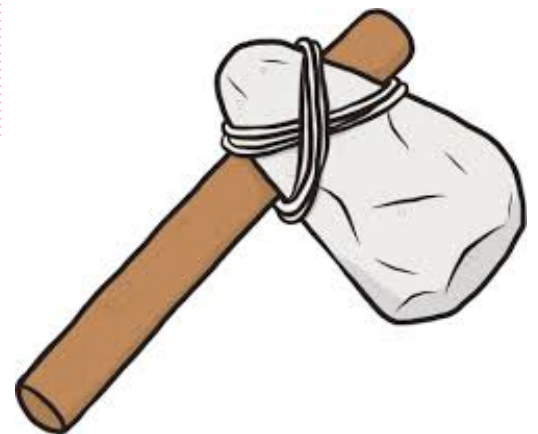
