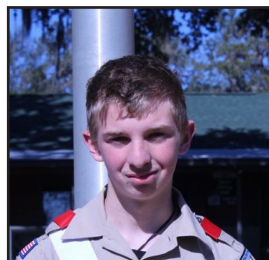

- Pirates of the Caribbean is the eleventh highest-grossing film series of all-time and it was the first franchise where more than one film grossed \$1 billion worldwide
- During filming, Johnny Depp wore contact lenses that acted like sunglasses so he wouldn't have to squint while facing the sun
- Robert De Niro was originally offered the role of Captain Jack Sparrow. However, he turned down the role because he thought that the film would do poorly at the box office
- Pirates of the Caribbean: Dead Man's Chest was the number 1 film of 2006, making almost \$1.8 billion at the worldwide box office
- Davy Jones' tentacles were partially real, the rest was CGI
- To create the 'fire' in the attraction, cloth, lights, and fans are all used. In fact, the Anaheim Fire Chief almost shut down the ride at one point for thinking it was real fire
- Pirates of the Caribbean at the Disneyland Resort was the very last ride Walt personally oversaw before he died in December 1966
