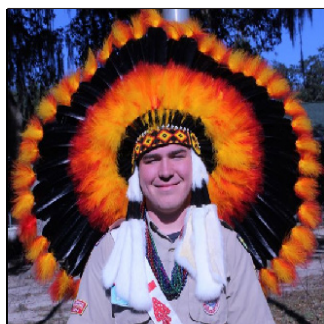
Hello Echockotee,

Oglala

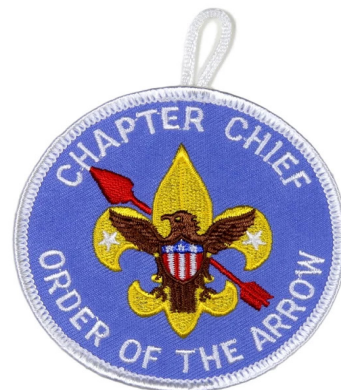
