



## Ordeal Candidate What to Bring List

*Cell Phones or other electronic devices are not allowed to be used on Friday or Saturday until after you complete the Induction ceremony.*

### **Needed at Check-in on Friday night**

- You do not need to be in your Field Uniform (Class A) to check in on Friday night. We suggest you wear work clothes (i.e., jeans and a Scout t-shirt).
- **BSA Medical Form (Parts A & B) (photocopy only; we retain the form for a year)**

**Things You'll Need Friday Night & Saturday** (You will move several times on Friday night and will need to carry these items with you.)

- Tent or Hammock (you will set it up in your Chapter campsite Friday night)
  - Bring a separate bag to hold your Field Uniform ("Class A") uniform (Scout shirt, Scout shorts or trousers, socks and a belt)
- Day pack or Backpack (for items below)
  - Sleeping bag or sleeping bag liner (no hammocks)
  - Sleeping pad (optional)
  - Ground cloth (use the one from your tent bag or a plastic sheet)
  - Your personal medications (in a zip lock bag with your name on it)
  - Toiletries (soap, toothbrush, etc.)
  - Work gloves
  - Jacket (seasonal)
  - A change of clothes as needed (socks, underwear, sweatshirt)
  - Rain gear
  - Hat
  - Water bottle or hydration pack
  - Sunscreen
  - Insect repellent
  - Flashlight
  - Note Pad and pencil or pen
- Spirit of the Arrow Booklet # 1 - "Upon a Lofty Journey"
- A cheerful attitude and willingness to serve

**Things You'll Need Saturday Afternoon** (You may leave them in your vehicle, or you will stow them in the designated place at the assembly area or in your Chapter campsite.)

- Full Field Uniform (Class "A" Scout Uniform)
- Towel
- Spending money to use at the OA Trading Post
